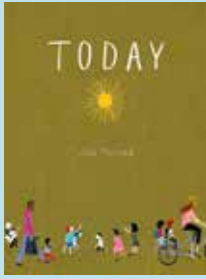

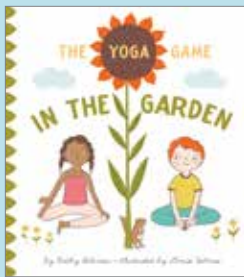

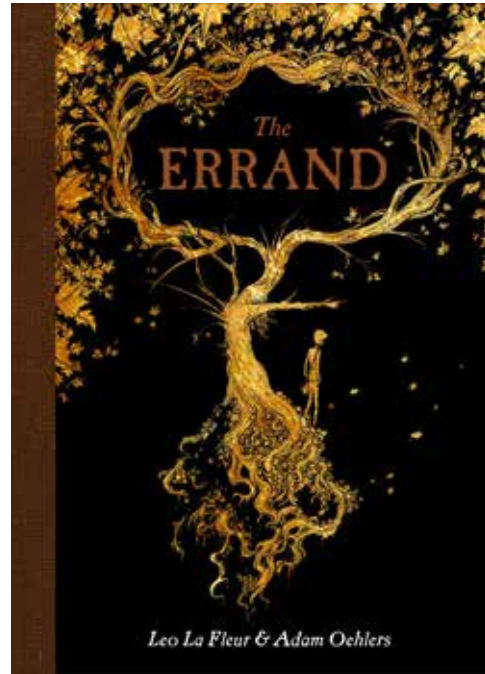

ADAM OEHLERS is a UK-based illustrator and sculptor whose work has earned him a British Fantasy Awards nomination.

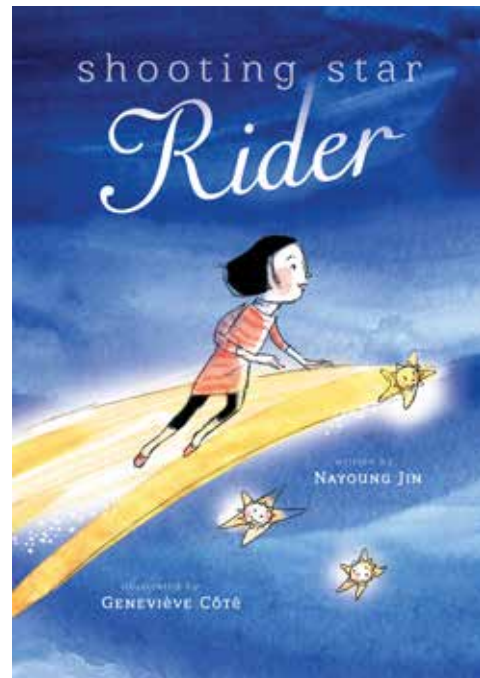

So begins Hans Christian Andersen's classic story of hardship, adventure, and friendship in a wild and wondrous world filled with helpful fish, braggy June bugs, and a mysterious mole. Thumbelina may be small, but her life is full of big adventures in this beautiful picture book illustrated with the modern paintings of Kelly Vivanco.

HANS CHRISTIAN ANDERSEN (1805-1875), the Danish author and poet, wrote numerous poems, plays, stories, and travel essays, but is best known for his fairy tales. He wrote over one hundred and fifty, published in numerous collections during his life, many of which are still in print today.

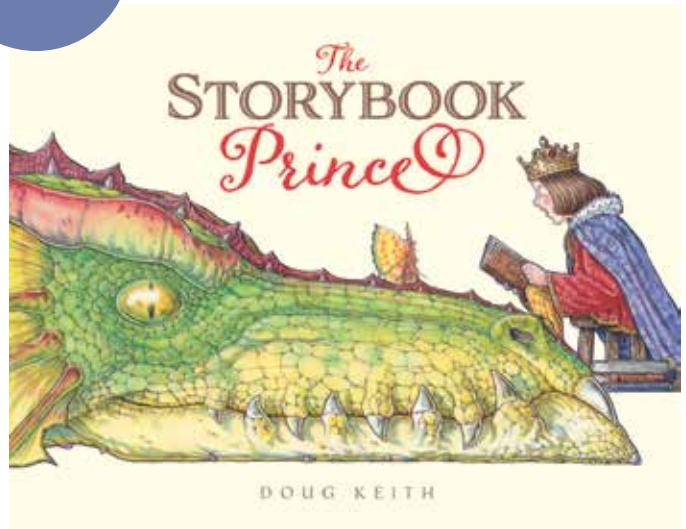

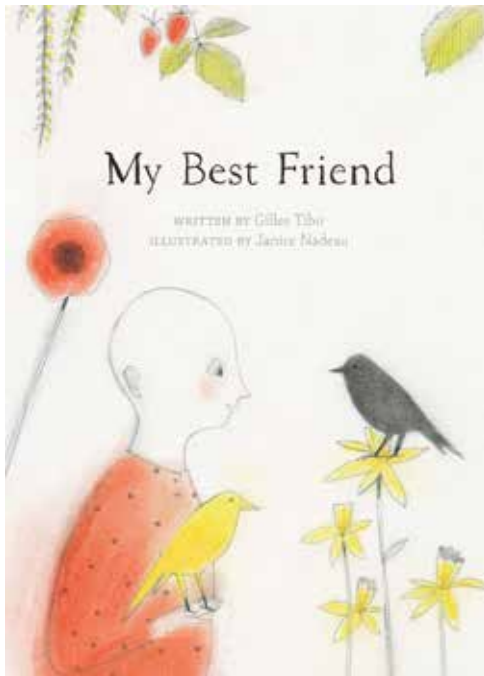


THE STORYBOOK PRINCE

Until one day a patient at the hospital—a little boy—speaks to the shadow, offering it a drink of water. The boy is fearful at first, but as he gets to know the shadow through their conversations, he realizes that she has feelings of her own. So begins a great friendship between an unlikely pair: a little boy, and Death.

This beautiful story addresses the difficult subject of death for young readers. It won the 2008 Governor General's Award for Children's Literature in its original French (*Ma meilleure amie*, les Éditions Québec Amérique, 2007) as well as the Grand Prix Illustration du Concours Lux 2008 and the Prix Alvine-Bélisle 2008. It is now available in English for the first time.

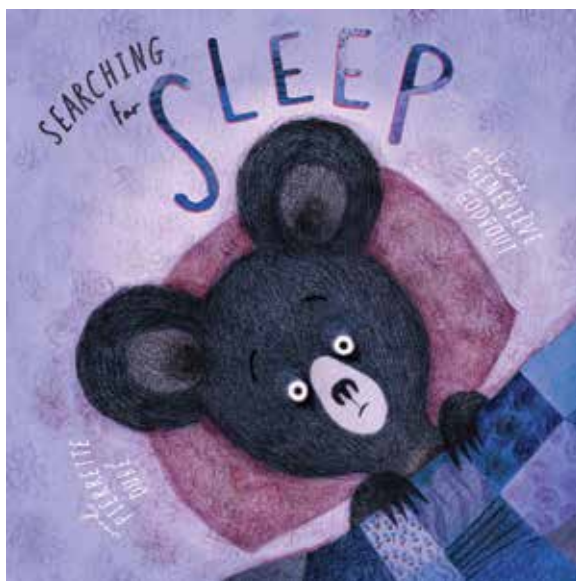

It isn't flattened under the rug, or hidden under the sheets either. Where could it be? *Searching for Sleep* was published in the original french as *Où s'est caché le sommeil?* (Éditions Les 400 coups, 2012).

 PIERRETTE DUBÉ is the author of over twenty books for children. She studied arts at the University of Montreal and translation at McGill University, and has worked as a proofreader, editor, and translator. Her books have won many French Canadian awards, including a Prix des libraires du Québec 2015, the Prix du livre M.
